Simply cash in - even without infrastructure. On the following pages, we explain step by step how easy the setup procedure is.


Part 1: Order TWINT QR code

Register on the TWINT merchant portal at portal.twint.ch or log in with your existing login.

To be able to cash in with TWINT, please create a new store. This is also necessary if you already use other TWINT products.

How to create a new store

Select "Order Stickers" on the home page.

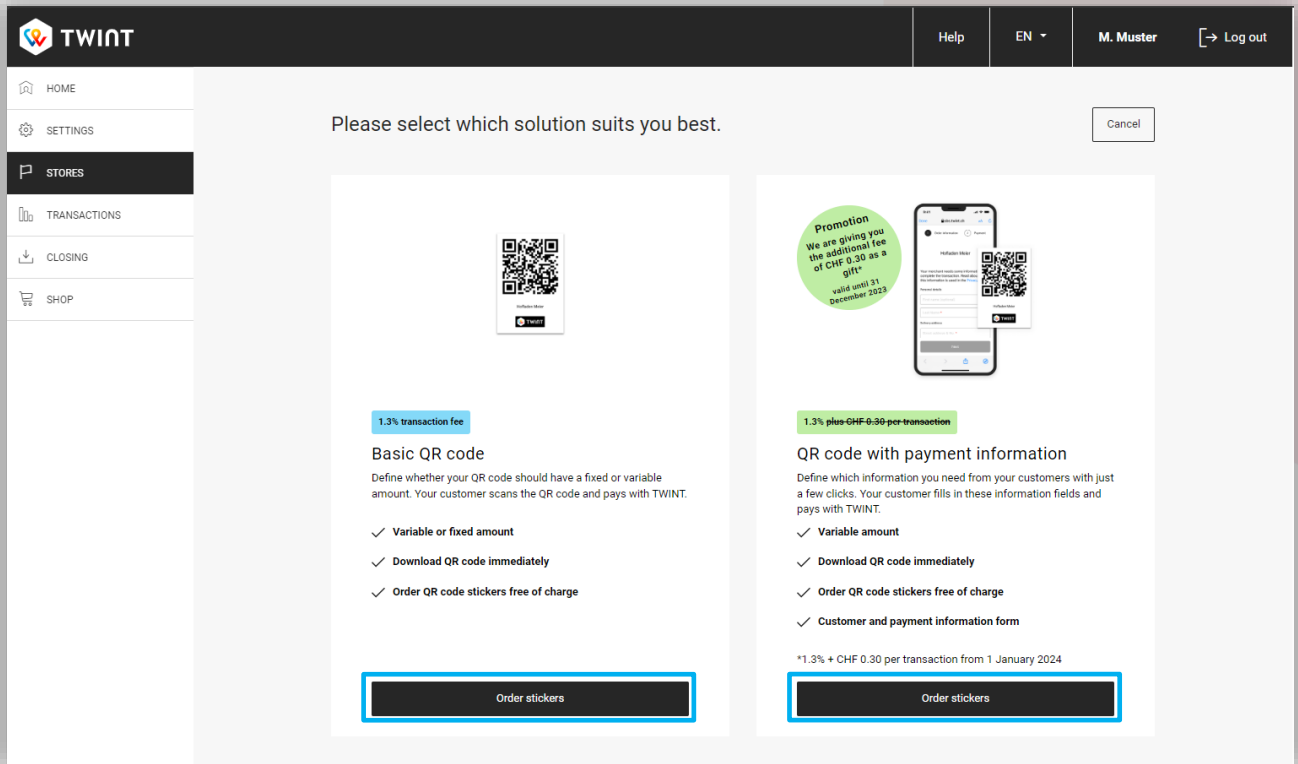

1. Basic details

Enter the information (name, address and logo) about your store as it should be displayed in the TWINT app.

Store

These details are displayed to your customers when they pay in the TWINT app.

Logo

Upload a logo that is displayed to your customers when they pay in the TWINT app. This gives the customer a visual confirmation during the payment process and thus additional assurance that the payment is taking place at the desired location.



Credit account

To which account should we transfer your TWINT earnings? Please select an appropriate account or add one. You can enter one account per store or use the same account for all stores.

For initial registration, a bank statement is required for verification. Please upload a receipt from the appropriate account. Must show: Name of company/account holder, address, IBAN/account number.

 **Note:** It is important that you enter your account details correctly in the TWINT merchant portal, otherwise we will not be able to process payments to you. 2. Configure form

If you have selected the "QR code with payment information", you can define here which information is mandatory or optional.

Configure form

Define here which mandatory or optional information you require from the payer in order to complete the transaction. You can have the following information included in the transaction: customer details and payment purpose. For example, for pre-orders, shipping to the desired address, allocation of payments and much more. The form can even be set up or amended after the QR code has been generated. A new QR code does not have to be generated.

i Please note: You are only allowed to use the data transmitted by the payer for the processing of this business transaction. Only ask for the data you need. This will allow for an easy payment.

2./3. Order QR code sticker

Choice of product and specification of the account for daily or weekly transfer of revenue.

For basic QR codes: QR code with freely selectable or fixed amount

The QR code sticker with freely selectable amount is ideal if you collect many different amounts. Your customers enter the exact amount when paying in the TWINT app.

QR code stickers with a fixed amount are practical if you regularly collect the same amounts. You define an amount of your choice per sticker. You can create as many amounts or stickers as you like.

Dispatch sticker

Optionally or in addition to the download, you can choose to send the stickers by mail. Define, if necessary, another shipping address for delivery. Specify a contact person especially if the company name is not visible on the mailbox. The shipment will arrive within four working days.

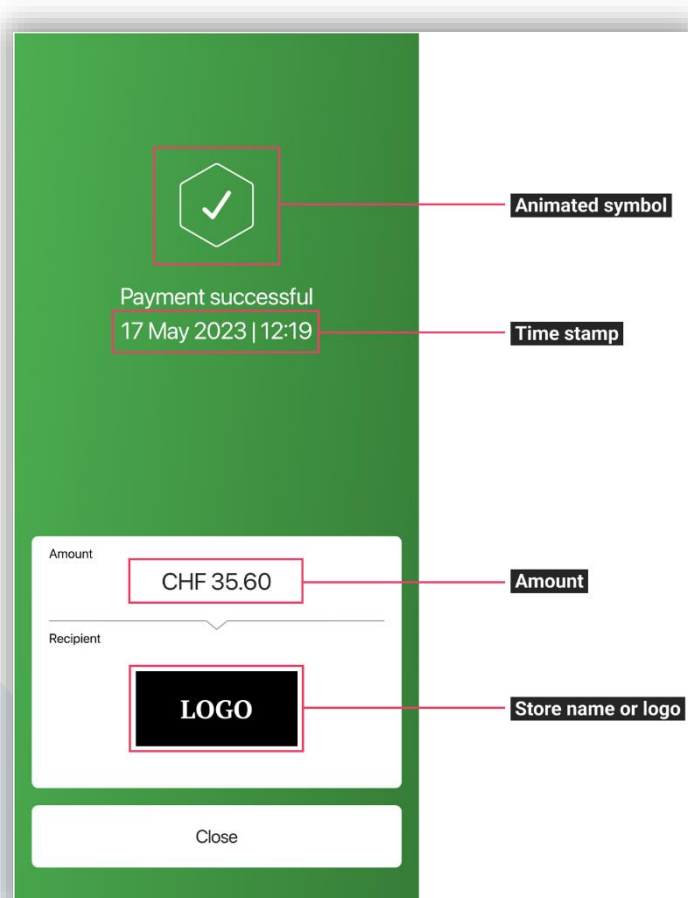

Part 2: other portal functions

Settings

Here you can manage users and other settings. For example, deputies can be added as additional users so that access to the TWINT merchant portal is guaranteed at all times. It should be noted here that all portal users receive the same authorizations.

The payout interval can be changed to daily or weekly at any time. This setting applies to all stores and the changeover takes place within a maximum of one week.

How often should the accrued amounts be paid out?



The payout interval will be changed after the current cycle is completed. The change can therefore take up to one week.
